Course Content	This course is aimed at fulfilling and supplementing Level 6 of the National Curriculum and NCEA Level 1, as well as revising and building upon material from previous years. Students will develop some flexibility in writing and speaking about familiar matters, express what they want to do (or do not want to do) and want others to do (or not to do), describe and understand others' descriptions of activities and events, and give and receive directions. Students will develop an ability to get the gist from a range of texts in listening and reading.	This course is aimed at fulfilling and supplementing Level 7 of the National Curriculum and NCEA Level 2, as well as revising and building upon material from previous years. Students will develop the ability to comprehend detail and summarise meaning in spoken and written Japanese, initiate and maintain conversation that may have some unpredictable content, and write extended passages presenting ideas and information logically and demonstrating their expanding knowledge of <i>kanji</i> .	This course is aimed at fulfilling and supplementing Level 8 of the National Curriculum and NCEA Level 3, as well as revising and building upon material from previous years. Students will develop the ability to interact flexibly in familiar social situations, recognise fine detail in spoken and written text, drawing inferences and conclusions from it, and use basic language patterns spontaneously and develop and support their points of view. This level is marked by an ability to provide details of motivation, perspective and conditions of decisions or choices.
Pre Requisites	A prerequisite of at least one year full time study of the Japanese language or an extended experience in Japan itself is required at this level.	A prerequisite of at least two years of full time study of the Japanese language or an extended experience in Japan itself, or sufficient credits gained at Year 11 (Level 1).	A prerequisite of at least three years of full time study of the Japanese language or an extended experience in Japan itself is required to study at this level, or sufficient credits gained at Year 12 (Level 2)
