
Scholarship Information 2019

Rathkeale College invites students who have a record of achieving at a level of excellence to apply for a Rathkeale or Trinity Schools' Foundation Scholarship.

RATHKEALE COLLEGE BOARDING SCHOLARSHIPS (FOUR AVAILABLE)

- Value of up to \$5,000 (to offset boarding fees).
- Boarding Scholarships will be awarded to boarding students who show outstanding prowess in one or more of the following areas; academia / sport / music / culture.
- In addition to talent, students must be able to demonstrate a history of commitment and application in this / these area(s).
- Evidence of a positive attitude towards school and learning will be sought.
- Available for Year 9 students only for a three-year period (Years 9 – 11) subject to:
 - Academic reports indicating a continuing positive attitude towards study;
 - A high level of achievement in the area(s) for which the scholarship has been awarded;
 - A record of full and enthusiastic participation in the wider life of the school and fulfilling the school's expectations as a role model to other students.

RATHKEALE FOUNDATION CULTURAL AND SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS (UP TO FIVE AVAILABLE)

- Value \$500 - \$2,500 per annum depending on the number awarded.
- Available for one or two years to day & boarding students in Year 9 who demonstrate a high level of commitment and achievement in any activity area aligned to sport, music or the performing arts.
- Financial constraints that some families experience may be taken into account.
- The award / continuation of the award is subject to:
 - Academic reports indicating a positive attitude towards classwork and study;
 - A high level of achievement / aptitude in the activity area of the scholarship award.

PROCEDURES (FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS)

- Applications for both the Rathkeale College and the Rathkeale Foundation Scholarships are to be made on the application form available from the school or on line at <http://www.rathkeale.school.nz/enrolment/scholarships/> and accompanied by the following:
 - The applicant's most recent school report/s (2018 and / or end of 2017);
 - A resume compiled by the student (preferably handwritten) of his achievements in his chosen area of activity and a brief (one page) personal statement about his commitment and aspirations. The submission of any portfolio is not required at this stage.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY JUNE 8TH 2018

- If not previously submitted, an Application for Admission to Rathkeale College (see www.rathkeale.school.nz/enrolments) must accompany this application. Our expectation is that students are provisionally enrolled.
- A short list of candidates will be determined from the information received and all applicants will be notified by Monday 18th June.
- Short listed candidates will sit an examination and attend an interview with the Principal or Deputy Principal on or by Wednesday 4th July (dates and times to be advised). Permission will also be sought to contact student's current teachers(s) and / or principal.
- Rathkeale College Boarding Scholarships 2018 recipients will be announced by Wednesday 25th July 2018.
- Any boarding student who does not receive a Boarding Scholarship, along with day boys are eligible for Rathkeale Foundation Trust Scholarship. Recipients will be advised by the Friday 7th September 2018.

PAPAWAI KAIKOKIRIKIRI LANDS TRUST SCHOLARSHIP - LEADERSHIP AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIPS (TWO AVAILABLE IN ANYONE YEAR)

- Available to students currently attending Hukarere Girls' College, Rathkeale College, St Matthew's Collegiate School or Te Aute College
- Must be able to whakapapa to a tangata whenoa hapu of Wairarapa

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION FINANCIAL SUPPORT (MINISTRY OF EDUCATION)

- Students must usually be boarders

ST MARTIN'S BURSARY

- Awarded to a student from the Mangaweka district who intends to board at Rathkeale College. The value of the Bursary (\$1,500) will offset some of the cost of the Tuition fees and Donation Dues. The Bursary is for the tenure of the student's time at Rathkeale College subject to satisfactory academic performance. Preference will be given to students of Anglican background and academic, sporting and cultural strengths will be considered.
- Applications by letter to the Principal Rathkeale College (marked St Martin's Bursary) submitted by the end of September 2016 will be considered.

- The school also receives funds from various anonymous sources to support families in financial need in order that their son(s) may continue their education at Rathkeale College. A condition for support is that students are currently enrolled.
